Why?

To ensure good conduct and best practice within the Lawn Tennis Association.

How?

Deployment of a team of Safeguarding practitioners to review and report upon their findings.

Outcome:

Successful provision of findings to support an ongoing investigation.

In 2018, the Lawn Tennis Association (LTA) commissioned an independent Safeguarding inquiry which comprised of a review of their internal conduct and operations.

Independent inquiries are necessary in Safeguarding in order to ensure the integrity and professionalism of persons in positions of authority.
